## Eligible Applicants must:

- Be Iraqi citizens and residents of Iraq now and throughout the application process.
- Possess high proficiency in written and oral English (recommended minimum TOEFL score of 500).

- Be full-time Iraqi university faculty members who possess, at a minimum, a master's degree and at least three years of university-level teaching experience or a PhD and no more than eight years of teaching experience.
- Be committed to classroom teaching and desire to strengthen teaching and leadership skills.



- Not have applied or be planning to apply for a U.S. green card or asylum status.
- Applicants cannot be dual citizens of the U.S. and Iraq.
- Able to travel to and remain in the U.S. during the dedicated grant period of June through September 2021.
